Grants in action in 2025

Gratitude grant of \$4500.00-requested for "Humane's Society not only rescues animals, they also help those in the community who have pets and are in need of assistance to continue care for their furry family member(s) due to financial restraints. Some community members also help foster the animals if the shelter gets over crowded and in turn, the Humane Society helps with providing needs to keep the animal(s) safe, healthy and comfortable. Using the funds, our lodge will help purchase items on the wish list from the Humane Society to lend a hand to those in need.

Grand lodge accepted proposal, and our lodge made it happen.

Freedom grant of \$1000.00- requested for "Gainesville Elks Lodge 990 would like to request \$1,000 Freedom Grant funds to present to the VA HONOR Center. The HONOR Center serves as a transitional facility for homeless veterans moving into independent living housing. Currently, the HONOR Center houses 46 military women and men veterans. The HONOR Center is a facility that provides programs to veterans with counseling, therapy, job skills training and other services to help make the transition from homeless into independent living.

Most veterans arrive at the HONOR Center with only the items they possess while living in a homeless situation. Allowing Gainesville Elks Lodge 990 to donate the check to the HONOR Center will help provide clothing, personal hygiene products and a wide array of other needs for our veterans. Foods and medical attention is provided from the funding of the VA and the HONOR Center.

Beacon grant of \$4000.00- requested for "As the holidays approach, finances become more of a burden. By providing food during the holidays to those in need, it helps give relief to the individuals and their families. Gainesville Elks Lodge 990 will be helping foster families through One More Child, veterans through the Malcom Randall Veterans Affairs Medical Center & The Honor Center, the small town of Waldo that still continues to struggle and whomever seeks out aid through our lodge. Members of Gainesville Elks 990 will be involved by 1. shopping for food items 2. dedicating time to help distribute 3. delivering to places that signed up.

Mike Yacovelli also helped with the urgent request late on Tuesday to ensure these veterans enjoyed a true ELKS HAPPY THANKGIVING"
